The Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival is now accepting applications for the Artistic Administration Intern Position. Successful candidates will be integral members of the Festival staff for its 53rd Season in July and August, 2026.

The Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival is an internationally acclaimed six-week summer festival of over 40 chamber music concerts and youth concerts performed by world-class musicians. Under the leadership of Artistic Director Marc Neikrug, the Festival gathers artists from around the world to perform in Santa Fe. The Artistic Administration Intern participates in all artist services for the six-week summer season. Primary duties include maintaining the Artistic Director's calendar, welcoming and orienting artists, driving artists from Albuquerque airport, preparing and distributing schedules and parts, rehearsal setups, and music preparation. Interns are also part of the social media capture team when time allows.

A successful applicant will have a classical music background; a valid driver's license; good communication, people, organizational, and computer skills; a positive attitude; the ability to work calmly in fast-paced environment; and be 21 years old by July 13, 2026. Enrollment in Arts Administration program and prior experience working with artists are both a plus.

Term of employment: June 29 – August 25, 2026. Hours will vary, \$17.00 per hour, housing in Santa Fe and a rental car are provided.

Note: Because we know many applicants will be returning to school, we are open to discussing slightly adjusted dates to accommodate individual academic schedules.
